1. Introduction

2. Installation

Step 1: Download the Plugin

1. Download the plugin ZIP file from the [official website](#) or WordPress repository.

Step 2: Install the Plugin

1. Log in to your WordPress admin dashboard.

4. Click **Install Now** and then **Activate Plugin**.

3. Plugin Settings

Number of Tags to Generate

- **Description:** Set the maximum number of tags to generate for each post.
- **Default Value:** 5
- **How to Configure:**
 1. Go to **Settings > SEO Tag Generator**.
 2. Enter the desired number in the **Number of Tags to Generate** field.
 3. Click **Save Settings**.

Exclude Words

- **Description:** Exclude specific words from being suggested as tags.
 - **Default Value:** None
 - **How to Configure:**
 1. Go to **Settings > SEO Tag Generator**.
 2. Enter the words you want to exclude, separated by commas, in the **Exclude Words** field.
 3. Click **Save Settings**.

4. Using the Plugin

Suggested Tags Meta Box

- **Description:** The plugin adds a meta box to the post editor that displays suggested tags based on the post content.
- **How to Use:**
 1. Create or edit a post.
 2. Scroll down to the **Suggested SEO Tags** meta box on the right side of the editor.
 3. Review the suggested tags and add them to your post if desired.

Auto-Insert Tags

- **Description:** The plugin can automatically insert the suggested tags into your post when you save or update it.
- **How to Enable:**
 1. The auto-insert feature is enabled by default.
 2. When you save or update a post, the suggested tags will be added automatically.

Q1: Can I customize the number of tags generated?

Yes, you can set the number of tags to generate in the plugin settings.

Q2: How do I exclude specific words from being suggested as tags?
